# Background

- No Communities & Collections in Research@Lincoln repository for indigenous research outputs & other content that had a Mātauraka Māori focus
- Some academic staff not aligned to a faculty or research centre  
=> No collection to move open access outputs to



# Creation of the Indigenous Knowledge and Mātauraka Māori repository collections

- Approached our indigenous research staff and our Deputy Vice-Chancellor (DVC), Māori and Pasifika for feedback and input
- Content for this new collection was originally sourced via a keyword search on 'Maori/Māori' in existing research outputs in the repository, with a note sent out to our community to get in touch if something wasn't correct
- Open access and metadata-only research outputs can be moved or mapped to the Mātauraka Māori collection (currently 209 outputs)
