


PLANTING CONCEPTS

- 1 Beside The Expressway
Buffer planting of mixed Conifer species.
- 2 Sports Fields
Groups of Eucalyptus delegatensis.
- 3 School Carpark And Entrance
Quercus palustris throughout the carpark and merged with Cedrus libani to mark the entrance.
- 4 Smaller Bicycle Park
Quercus palustris merging into Fraxinus ornus in courtyard 1.
- 5 Main Pedestrian Entrance
Quercus palustris as the theme, merging into Fraxinus raywoodii in courtyard 2.
- 6 Larger Bicycle Park And Nottingham Ave Entrance
Quercus palustris merging into Fraxinus excelsior 'Pendula' around the Nottingham Ave pedestrian /cyclist entrance.
- 7 Beside Nottingham Stream And The Lakes
Weeping theme continued with Salix babylonica.
- 8 Courtyard 1
Fraxinus ornus planting theme, with one Fraxinus excelsior.
- 9 Courtyard 2
Fraxinus raywoodii as the planting theme, merged with Fraxinus ornus into courtyards 1 and 3.
- 10 Courtyard 3
Fraxinus ornus as the planting theme, with one Fraxinus excelsior.
- 11 Outdoor Teaching Area
Mixed evergreen planting for all year privacy.
- 12 Community Courtyard
Fraxinus ornus as the planting theme.
- 13 Community Carpark
A theme of Fraxinus excelsior 'Pendula'




