Library, Teaching and Learning has launched Data@Lincoln, a new platform where researchers can **publish data** to meet funder and publisher requirements, and to increase the citations, visibility and impact of their research.

Lincoln University's Open Access policy ensures that the research produced here is **accessible and reusable** by everyone. Dissemination of data is at the core of research and collaboration.

Each researcher at Lincoln University will be allocated an initial **50GB of space** to publish their data while collaborative projects can be created with an initial 10GB. Any format of data can be published on Data@Lincoln, including raw data or analysed datasets, from genomes and spreadsheets to images and audio files.

Openly available data in citable form will **increase citations**, which will consequently help in raising impact and profile. Researchers will be able to track usage metrics – views, downloads, citations and Altmetric ratings.

Datasets published on Data@Lincoln will be **indexed in Google Dataset Search**. They are also discoverable in our own LibrarySearch, along with the other university collections we maintain including **Research@Lincoln**, **Living Heritage**, and **Journals@Lincoln**.



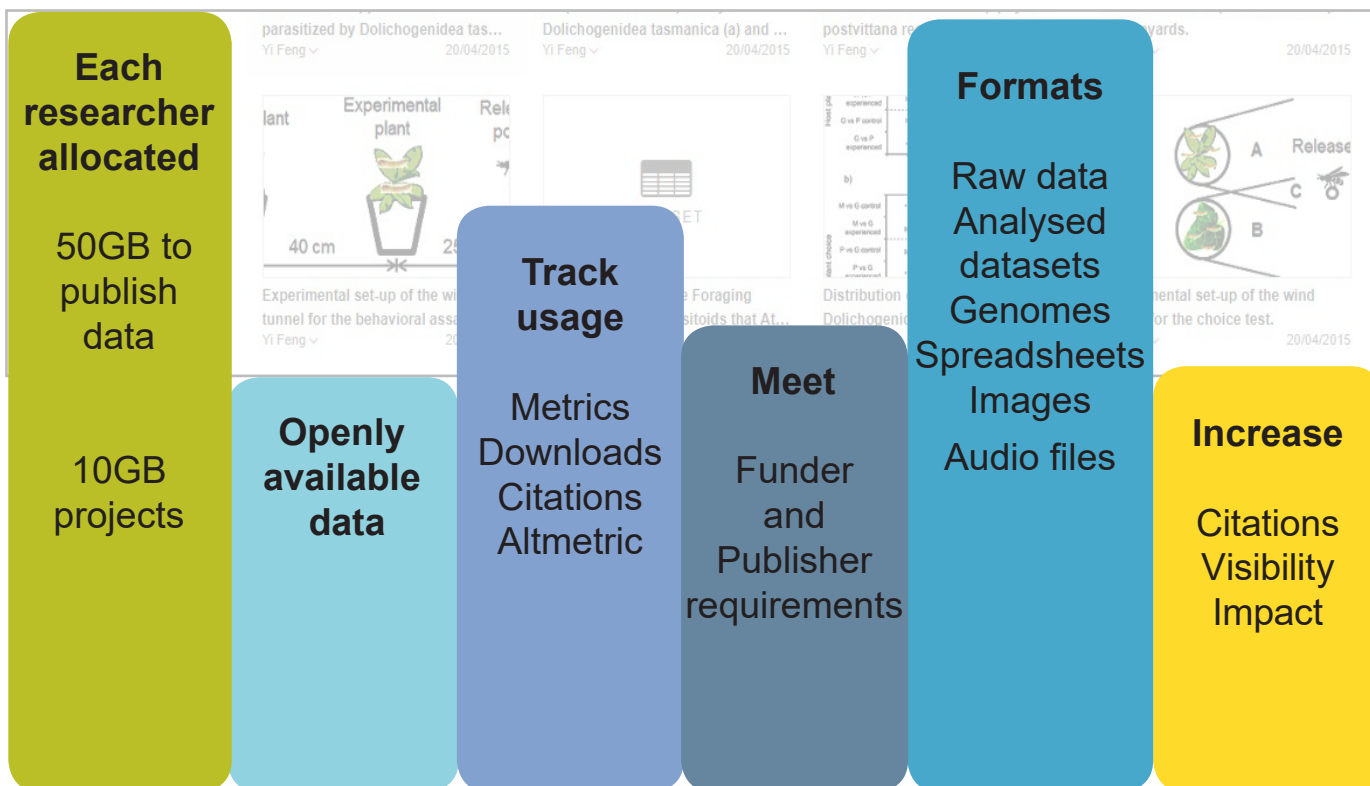
